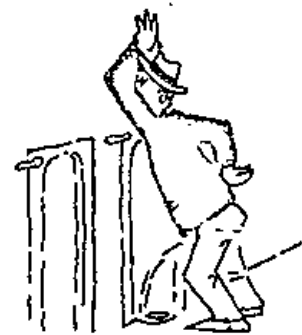
GCS CONTINUED

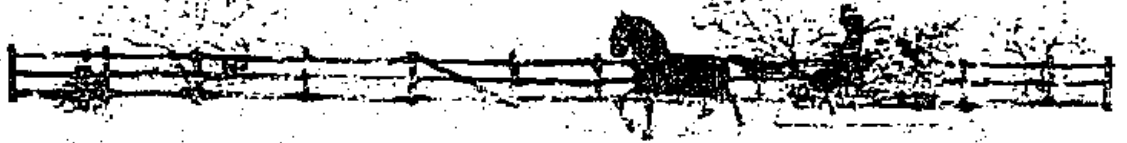
