## NATIONAL REACTION TO TGII

Our recent editorial on the tragic death of Richard Heakin and the subsequent verdict has caused a stir among several of the national Gay organizations. We have received wide, favorable comment from both East and West coasts regarding it. These unfortunate happenings have, and should continue to be, a rallying point to the Tucson Gay Community. Just as the Stonewall riots in New York began a nationwide movement, we believe that even in tragedy, there is some good.

In the December 3-16 issue of Pacific Coast Times, an article written by Martin Smith, unfortunately, misses this point. In quoting Mr. Smith....."For too long the silent (gay) majority has put up with society judging us on the visible gays, the bar queen and activists, (who are) the minority of us. For too long the silent (gay) majority has had to put up with self elected spokespersons telling the world 'we homosexuals this' and 'we homosexuals that' when 'we homosexuals' have no common view on any matter least of all what we want from society and life. Will the noisy minority please sit down and rejoin the majority so we can all get on with the job of living and liberating....first ourselves and then society."

## FOOD DRIVE

The food drive, sponsored by MCC and GCS and all the bar owners, begins tonight. Food gets you free drinks as explained in last issue. There has been some talk that the recipient of this food, Tucson Food Bank, is anti-Gay. It is our understanding that anyone who is in desperate need of food may draw from the food bank provided he or she applies through the proper agency. In the case of the Gay Community, you should apply through Gay Community Services. The food bank does not distribute food except through authorized agencies.

There is no question that the majority of Gay persons are invisible, and they are perfectly welcome to sit down and remain silent. However, when laws threatening all Gays, silent and vocal; Gays being harrassed, beaten, murdered; Gays who only want equal time and space, then we feel it is up to us, even if we are to be labeled the vocal minority, to exercise our right to speak up when it is necessary, and let the Martin Smiths reap the harvest of our efforts for equality and decency and a fair share of our place in society. We all should share at least this 'common view'.

We don't want to make waves, but we won't sit down. Sorry Martin, but we couldn't disagree with you more.

## AWARDS GIVEN

Last Saturday night was, as promised, a big night at Dale's Graduate. A packed house enjoyed an excellent drag show featuring several performers from Phoenix. 




