The two would be murderers who attacked our Gay brother drove a 1965 or older, faded dark blue Chevrolet. A statue of Jesus was in the center of the dashboard. The two were described as: Chicano, both about 5'10" tall. One about 22 who actually did the beating with a wrench, with dark curly hair and tatoos of a shield or wings on both forearms and pock mark on his face. The other about 24, had long hair and they were working as a pair. Police have been notified.....

and most important introducing themselves. In
a brief interview Ken and Mark stated they were
available for questions and wanted the Gay
Community to know that reporting any problems
to them will be handled discreetly. When you
see these two uniformed men in the bars, try to
get acquainted and you will find out that they
are two really great guys.

While it is not the policy or intention of TGN
to criticize or ridicule others, we do intend

Referring to the Tucson Gay Coalition
